

Mr. Pascal Rheaume

- Captain Rhéaume graduated from the Institut Maritime du Québec in 2000, obtained his master's certificate and sailed on various commercial vessels until 2006.
- He joined the Corporation des pilotes du Bas Saint-Laurent (CPBSL) in 2008 and became a class "A" pilot in 2016.
- He is involved as a pilot trainer for the Maritime Simulation and Resources Center (MSRC) and sits on the electronic navigation committee of the CPBSL.
- Captain Rhéaume acted as an expert pilot, in a project granted by the Canadian Hydrographic Service, to develop new S-100 standards (S-102 bathymetry, S-111 surface currents and S104 tides). These new standards will provide navigators with access to dynamic information and greater versatility in the display of data on electronic charts on board. His involvement gives him the opportunity to present this work at various conferences to the hydrographic and maritime community.
